Because math is built on previously taught skills, attached are several review sheets for your child to complete in the summer.

The attached math handouts will be collected on **Thursday, September 3rd** and will count as the first math grade for the first trimester. Also, please be sure to continue to review the basic multiplication and division facts with your child.

As part of the English Language Arts curriculum, your child will read ONE novel. The novel choices are *No Talking* by Andrew Clements and *Back in Time with Benjamin Franklin* by Dan Gutman. Along with reading the book, your child must complete the Story Bag assignment. Directions for the assignment are on the attached paper. The Story Bag will be collected on **Thursday, September 3rd**. Your child will also present the Story Bag to the class on **Thursday, September 3rd**. This assignment will be the first grade for Reading, Writing, and Communication.

The book that will be read immediately in September is *Maniac Magee* by Jerry Spinelli. The students will need this book by **Monday, September 7th**. The other novels that are read in fifth grade are listed on the wiki page.
